**Everything possible is done to ensure that this information is correct, but you MUST confirm that information has not changed before you prepare your application.**

<b>Graduate Medicine</b>	Prospective students are generally selected using three criteria: <b>GAMSAT</b> (includes 1 <sup>st</sup> Year Biology and Chemistry and Year 12 Physics knowledge), <b>GPA</b> and an <b>Interview</b> (mostly MMI). In addition, the <b>University of Melbourne</b> is restructuring its Medicine Degree for 2022 entry so keep updated at <a href="https://medicine.unimelb.edu.au/news-and-events/towards-2022-the-new-doctor-of-medicine">https://medicine.unimelb.edu.au/news-and-events/towards-2022-the-new-doctor-of-medicine</a> . <b>Monash University (Gippsland)</b> requires an UG degree from Monash (most places allocated to Biomedical Science, with a few places for Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, and Science – may require designated units)
<b>*</b>	<b>Graduate Medicine degree is open to Graduates only.</b> Some of the universities offering these courses also offer limited <b>Provisional Entry or pathways for school leavers</b> , and generally these require you to do your Undergraduate studies through this university and meet all further selection criteria as set by each institution.

If residency or citizenship were to be granted before selection, students without a UCAT result would not be eligible (other than at JCU).
